

Managing Agent for Water Meadow Cottage Frequently Asked Questions

How can I pay?

Invoices are issued in £BPS and are payable by card, cheque and bank transfer. By request, invoices can also be issued in \$USD and Euros, which are payable by cheque and bank transfer only.

What amenities are included in the letting fee?

- Basic food preparation, household and personal care products;
- Bed linen, towels, beach towels, sun loungers, sun umbrella, picnic kit, and hair dryer;
- The fireplaces fully fuelled and the BBQ prepared to light;
- Electricity, water, gas, WIFI and satellite TV;
- For guests staying for periods longer than 1 week the property will be cleaned once every 4 days.

What Services can be provided?

A range of extra services can be provided on request, including but not limited to: chauffeurs, car hire, area tour guides, caterers, cleaners, child minders, fitness instructors, beauty and massage therapists, nail technicians, hair stylists, and make-up artists.

What will I find on-hand in the "Honesty Larder":

- A selection of wines, spirits and mixers;
- Dry-store goods and condiments;
- A selection of high quality, effective and utterly indulgent Spa products from around the world.

All items are clearly labelled and are competitively priced with the high street. Members enjoy 10% of listed prices.

How child-friendly is WMC?

We welcome children with numerous games, toys, books and DVDs but the cottage has not been toddler/young child proofed with items such as cabinet/draw locks or socket protectors. Other essential child care items are available on request at a nominal surcharge.

There is plenty of fun to be had outdoors, however the garden runs along a river's edge which is unfenced, so supervision is required at all times in this area. The riverbank is steep in places, and adults as well as children must take care. There is an enclosed garden facing the terrace which serves as a natural crèche.

How disabled-friendly is the cottage?

Given the age and structure of the cottage disabled access is limited and currently the cottage is NOT equipped with hearing impaired fire alarms.

Are all pets welcome?

The only pets allowed on the property are either one large dog or two small dogs and prior approval is required. A £25 per dog per night fee applies. A Dog amenities hamper is provided which includes: a blanket bed, bowls, wet and dry food, treats, paw wipes and a spare torch.

Does the cottage give me direct access to the Palace?

No. We must request that you don't trespass outside the bounds of the property or wander to other parts of the Blenheim Palace Estate other than through the Palace's public entrance located in Woodstock.

Can I fish on the river?

Yes, though you must stay on the property at all times, and purchase a rod licence from the Post Office or online in advance.

Can I smoke in the cottage?

Smoking is not permitted inside the property and if smoking outside, we request that smokers safely dispose of their cigarette, pipe or cigar waste in a designated ashtray and not on the grounds.

How good is mobile phone reception?

Due to the isolated nature of the cottage, there may be limited or no mobile phone signal available dependant on your provider. For safety and convenience there is a land line available from which all calls made will be itemised and billed to you at the end of your stay.

What if I break or damage something during my stay?

Any breakages or damage will be deducted from your Security Deposit which is paid before arrival.

Do the images I've seen accurately reflect the cottage at the time of my booking?

Yes, the cottage is newly refurbished and opened in the spring of 2013. As part of our constant striving to make the cottage as clean and comfortable as possible, some furniture and/or furnishings may be periodically replaced or exchanged, meaning some photographs may have small variances in depicting the property and gardens (which will only have grown fuller).
